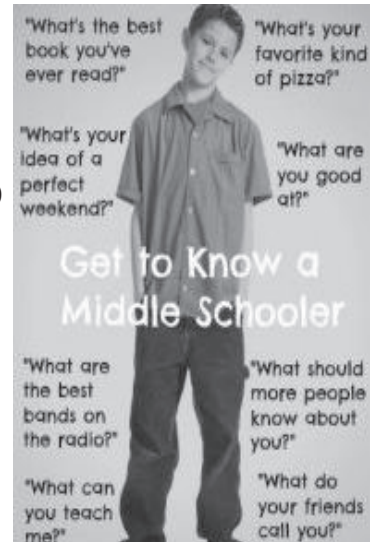
RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults)

ABUSE AWARENESS TRAINING FOR ADULTS

In order to create a safe environment in the workplace, neighborhood, home and church and to acquaint Archdiocesan personnel with policies and reporting procedures, the Archdiocese provides Abuse Awareness Training for Adults on an ongoing basis. Attendance at the training is mandatory for all adults, over the age of 18 who volunteer in any ministry, in any parish within the Archdiocese of Santa Fe. Pre-registration is necessary. These workshops are sponsored by the Archdiocese of Santa Fe. Note: Do not bring children. No one under the age of 18 is allowed in the workshop.
